NEW YEARS DAY AUTOTEST

1. Bournemouth & District Car Club will organise a Clubsport Autotest on Friday 1st January 2010 at Poole Ferry Terminal, New Quay Road, Poole.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit Number – tba
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of Bournemouth & District, Woolbridge, Wessex, Southsea and Salisbury & Shaftsbury Motor/Car Clubs.
5. The start and finish will be at the venue, and the programme is as follows: -
Venue open: 09:00am
Scrutineering: 09:15am
First test at 10:30 am.
Any competitor not signed on by 20 minutes before the start time may be excluded.
Provision results: 16:30pm
Event finishes: 17:00pm
6. The maximum entry for the event is 40 and the minimum is 15. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.
7. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and the entry fee is £15.
Entry fees will be refunded less a £2.50 administration charge if withdrawal is notified to the Secretary of the meeting prior to the closing date.

**The closing date for entries is 21st December 2009.
Any entry received after the closing date will incur a £5 penalty fee.**

- a) Saloons up to 1100cc and under 11ft overall length
 - b) Saloons over 1100cc and under 11ft overall length
 - c) Saloons over 11ft and under 13ft overall length
 - d) Saloons over 13ft overall length
 - e) Sports Cars
 - f) Specials and Kit cars

10. Awards will be presented as follows:
- Fastest Time of Day
 - First Lady (subject to 3 Lady starters)
 - 1st Novice (subject to 3 novice starters)
 - 1st in Class
 - 2nd in Class (subject to 5 class starters)
 - 3rd in Class (subject to 9 class starters)

12. Details of the tests will be given at signing on. Each competitor will have at least two runs at each test to count for the results and the order of attempting tests will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

13. Practising is not permitted.

14. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.

15. All vehicles must be adequately silenced and use road going tyres.

16. Timing will be by hand held stop watches.

17. The starting signal will be verbal and timing will begin when the front wheels cross the baulk line.

18. Final instructions will be issued at signing on and will not be posted. Please assume your entry has been accepted unless notified.
