## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1.Bournemouth & District Car Club and Woolbridge Motor Club will copromote a Clubmans Production Car Autotest on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2019 at Blandford Camp, Blandford, Dorset, DT11 8RH.

2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Motorsport UK Permit Number TBA.

4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising Clubs and fully paid up members of:- Farnborough Motor Club, Plymouth Motor Club, Southsea Motor Club and Salisbury & Shaftsbury Car Club.

5. The start and finish will be at the venue, and the program is as follows: -Venue open: 09:00am Scrutineering: 09:15am First test at 10:30 am. Any competitor not signed on by 20 minutes before the start time may be excluded.

6. The event will consist of 4 classes as follows:

- A) Cars up to 1300cc
- B) Cars between 1301cc and 1600cc
- C) Cars between 1601cc and 2000cc
- D) Cars over 2001cc
- No four- wheel drive vehicles are permitted.

7. Awards will be presented as follows:
Fastest Time of Day
1st in Class
2nd in Class (subject to 4 class starters)
3rd in Class (subject to 9 class starters)
1st Under 23 (subject to 3 U23 Starters)

First Lady (subject to 3 Lady starters)

1st Novice (subject to 3 novice starters) A novice is defined as a driver who has never won an overall, class or novice award on any autotest or autosolo. No competitor can win more than one award

8. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2019. The entry fee is **£25**. For those competitors aged 23 and under the entry fee is **£10**.

## Any entries forms received after the closing date will be subject to a £5 surcharge – there will be no exceptions.

All entries must be made on the official form and be accompanied by the entry fee. The organisers are able to accept payment by credit or debit cards. There is no fee for using this facility.

10. The maximum entry for the event is 40 and the minimum is 25. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

12. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees will be refunded if withdrawal is notified to the Secretary of the meeting prior to the closing date.

13. Details of the tests will be given at signing on. Each competitor will have at least two runs at each test to count for the results and the order of attempting tests will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

14. Practicing is not permitted.

15. Passengers over the age of 12 (in a closed car) or 16 (in an open car) may be carried.

16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event. Any protests must be made in accordance with C(d)46-49.

17. All vehicles must be adequately silenced.

18. No four- wheel drive vehicles are permitted

19. Timing will be by hand held stop watches.

20. The starting signal will be verbal and timing will begin when the front wheels cross the baulk line.

21. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written.

22. In order to comply with regulations set down by the MOD it is necessary for the organiser to provide details in advance of all vehicles and personnel intending to enter the venue in relation to the event. If applicable, please write the registration number, make and model of your tow vehicle and names and addresses of any passengers on the of the entry form. We would also advise you to bring some photographic identification (passport or driving license) to the venue as this will have to be shown at the Guardroom on entry.

23. Competitors are reminded that the road between the camp entrance and the test venue should be treated the same way as the public highway, i.e. seat belts must be worn, speed limits adhered to, beware of pedestrians and cyclists. **We could lose the use of the venue if you fail to do this!** 

24. Final instructions will be issued at signing on and will not be posted. Please assume your entry has been accepted unless notified.

#### 25. ALL SPILLAGES MUST BE NOTIFIED TO AN OFFICIAL ASAP – FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN YOU BEING EXCLUDED FROM THE EVENT.
